OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. President Johnson updated the members on the foam replacement process and stated that he talked with Chief Chris Davis (OSFM) Foam Point of Contact, who informed President Johnson that any further foam disposals have been placed on hold until April or thereafter due to the current storage facility being at capacity.
- 2. President Johnson thanked everyone that attended the North Carolina Association of Fire Chief's Mid-Winter-Conference and stated that all our lottery winners attended the conference. Our next lottery picks for both Mid-Winter and FDIC will take place in September this year.
- 3. President Johnson announced that both Chief Brock (Beaver Dam) and Chief Herndon (Grays Creek) have indicated interest in the current vacant Vice-President's Position. Prior to our March 2025 meeting President Johnson will meet with both to further discuss the requirements and responsibilities of the position. We will vote to fill the position during our March 24th meeting hosted by the Vander Fire District.
- 4. President Johnson reminded the membership that County Manager Grier should have our budget ready for release the first week of March.
- 5. The Cyber Security Project that 9 VFDs signed on with FTCC is up and running and everyone should have received a coordination call from the Project Manager.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. President Johnson recognized Deputy Chief Wayne Sherrill (Retired) Grays Creek Station 24 Fire Department, for his 45 years of volunteer service, serving both as Board of Director and for the past ten years as Deputy Chief. Chief Sherrill was presented with the Association Appreciation Plaque.
- Deputy Chief Richtmeyer announced new Chief Officer promotions as a result of the retirements of Deputy Chief Miguel Alvarez and Ronnie Willet. Chief Willet accepted a position with the National Fire Academy in Emmittsburg, Maryland and is already gone. Chief Alvarez was recognized during a ceremony last Friday. Moving forward there will only be two (2) Deputy Chiefs as a result of an organizational realignment.

- 3. President Johnson announced that another \$50,000 ARP funding opportunity for volunteer departments is available. The PIO Email announcing the opportunity is in everyone's packet. VFDs that previously received an ARP loan are also eligible to apply for consideration.
- 4. President Johnson announced that providing the Chiefs 101 curriculum is updated by OSFM we will sponsor an upgrade class during our August 2025 meeting here at the college. Chief Melvin (Retired) has agreed to run the class if updated and made current.
- 5. President Johnson included in everyone's packet pictures of the FTCC Regional Training Center Phase II project, showing the addition of a single story residential and a two story commercial apartment complex burn building progress.

He provided an example that it is important to dispatch Tankers

/ Tenders to areas without hydrants and requested that all Chiefs coordinate with Shenna Evans to properly apply the correct classification for our apparatuses.
