

**Cumberland County Fire Chief's Association**  
**October 23, 2000, 7:00 PM**

Called to order by President Jimmy Hall at 7:00 PM with 16 members and 8 associate members present. Meeting held at CCSD Assembly Room.

President Hall stated the EMS Committee had met and is in a holding pattern. A discussion on the EMS developed with no one coming to a solution at this time.

Chief Bullard asked the location of the Fire House Software 5.0 .

President Hall asked Chief Barnes if he had a status report on the Internet Connection. Chief Barnes presented the status report on the Internet Connection as printed below:

**Status Report on Internet Connection  
for Chief's Association Minutes  
October 2000**

Chief Barnes has continued to meet with Mr. Dennis Lindgrin of the County MIS office. We are still working with Firehouse to get the correct software version so that our server can be loaded properly. Once this is finished, Dennis will test it over Time Warner's Roadrunner system to insure its compatibility. This test must prove successful for us to use Roadrunner. If not, its back to the old dial up phone lines and the usability of our server is questionable.

Time Warner has completed the survey of our 22 fire stations. Roadrunner service can be available to all except Linden and Beaver Dam.

At this time, Time Warner is quoting \$63.96 per station per month. I believe this remains too high for our application. If the Roadrunner test proves successful, we should then put the pressure on to quote our rate at the \$40.00 per month enjoyed by residential customers. However, this cannot be undertaken until after the test by Mr. Lindgrin.

President Hall asked that Deputy Chief James Hall, FFD, <sup>ASSIST</sup> take over this committee.

**Update of November 3, 2000**

After three sets of software, we now believe that Mr. Lindgrin has the correct version. He intends to test the system this weekend (11/4/2000).
