9. There was some discussion concerning the state fire code. A request was made by the association to have a letter drafted supporting the NFPA-1 state fire code. This letter is to be forwarded to the North Carolina Fire Commissioners office.
10. Assistant Chief David Chavis announced a drill that his department would be conducting November 10. David also requested that the planning and research committee look into the possibility of forming foam banks throughout the county.
