Cumberland County Fire Chief's Association December 20 1999 - 7:00 PM

Called to order by President Jimmy Hall at 7:00 PM with 16 members and 6 associate members present. Meeting held at Cumberland County Law Enforcement Center, Sheriff's Department Assembly Room.

Opening prayer provided by Sheriff" Moose" Butler.

Reading of Minutes: President Hall asked that the reading of the minutes be suspended due to the agenda for the evening. No Objections noted.

Hurricane Floyd-Edgecombe Co. Presentation: Chief Hall introduced James Mercer, Director of the Edgecombe County Emergency Management and Fire Marshal's Office. Also with him was Fire Chief Donald Pollard, Princeville Fire Department.

James and Don showed a slide presentation of the devastation Hurricane Floyd left in its wake. They also explained how they had to cope with the flooding, and the high spirit of the people who had to start over from the beginning.

CCSD: Sheriff Butler told the association that he was glad everyone enjoyed the meal, and asked the President to excuse him as he had an important phone call at 8PM.

Automatic Electronic Defibrillation (AED): President Hall introduced Doctor Keith Henderson ALS Medical Director. Dr. Henderson then introduced his wife Linda who worked also on this presentation. Dr. Henderson showed a slide presentation on AED and how it has increased the percentage of patients who were in ventricular fibrillation upon EMS arrival.

Dr. Henderson explained that 350,000 people suffer cardiac arrest each year.

Chain of survival is notification, CPR, early defibrillation ALS Airway Epinephrine

From January 1998 to July 1999 a total of 416 cardiac arrests were handled.

Medical arrests= 371 (89,1%) ventricular Fibrillation= 138 (37,16%)

Results on arrival at ER: rocs=37, w/pulse=31, survival to discharge=13

Survivor statistics: 83% had CPR, 43% had FD/QRV intervention.

Old Business: President Hall recognized Chief Mark Barnes, turn-out gear that was given to him from the departments in Michigan, was delivered to the Princeville, N C Fire Department.

New Business:

Fire/EMS Memorial: President hall recognized Chief Mike Middleton who passed out a copy of the Firemen's Prayer and asked for a vote to change the last sentence to read – Please bless with your protecting hand, my children and my wife (or change to): my family one and all.

Motion made by Chief Danny Matthews to change last sentence to read my family one and all, 2nd by Chief Freddie Johnson. Motion carried 16/0 for the change.

A list of personnel that will be on the memorial was handed out and asked chiefs to verify correctness of there personnel going on the memorial.

A list of contributors was handed out, so everyone could see who has contributed.

President Hall asked the treasurer if any money was available in the associations account that could be contributed to the memorial fund. Treasurer Freddie Johnson Jr. stated the there was \$1,000 in the savings account that could be used.

A motion was made by Chief Freddie Johnson to donate \$1,000 dollars to the memorial fund, 2nd by Chief Mark Barnes. Motion carried, 16/0

Chief Middleton stated memorial should be finished in 2-1/2 months

EMS: President Hall recognized Wally Ainsworth, EMS Director. Wally stated that he was looking into prices on backboard purchases from Iron Duck Board. To get prices.

City of Fayetteville Fire Department: President Hall recognized Assistant Chief Allen Nobles. Chief Nobles discussed the need for more training in the field of Critical Incident Stress Debriefing (CISD)

<u>Fire Marshal:</u> President Hall recognized Ricky Strickland, who passed out a copy of Firehouse Training and a CD on E911 Data and map viewer from Mike Osborne.
