NEW BUSINESS:

Chief Alan Nobles presented information from Firefighters in Christ to the association; literature was available for each department. Anyone interested in organizing a Chapter in Cumberland County should contact Chief Nobles.

Elliott Rich, Director of EMS, was introduced. He addressed the association and extended his support.

OLD BUSINESS:

Chief J.F. Hall presented to the association a proposal for purchasing foam trailer(s) for the county.

RECOMMENDATION;

1 Place a minimum of three (3) fully equipped, 500 gallon foam trailers throughout the county. Trailers are designed to be pulled by a 4X4 pick-up truck. Trailers are to be placed in fully manned stations. The cost of a complete unit (not including foam) is \$25,000.

2 Money to purchase the trailers is to come from the 2% monies over a three (3) year period.

3 Recommendations from the C.C.F.F.T.F. will be presented to the C.C.F.C.A. pertaining specifications, General Operation Guidelines, and how the units are to be dispatched and maintained.

Chief Middleton made a motion to accept the recommendation as presented by the task force. That the task force present to the association a set of specifications, and a payment plan for the purchase of one (1) unit and for the purchase of three (3) units.

Chief Jones second the motion. Motion passed by show of hands.

Joe Johnson stated that he was continuing to pursue his attempts in obtaining needed personnel; Senator Tally to continues to support his efforts.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Arson Task Force - Commander Naylor gave a report of achievements that the task force has made since its inception.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: (cont.)

County Commissioners - Johnny Evans received a suggestion that Plot Plans be changed to include the Fire District in the Title Block, this would insure that plans were given to the correct fire department.

Al Rozier, Vander Fire Department, made a motion that a recommendation be sent to the Cumberland County Joint Planning Board to make this addition in the Title Block on the Preliminary and Final Plot Plans.

Chief Middleton second the motion. Motion passed by show of hands.

Chief Goodman personally expressed his gratitude to all county departments who assisted with the incident on Pope Air Force Base last month.
