President Hall advised that the foam trailers were on display outside display. Fire Marshal R. Strickland advised that the reducers had been ordered.

Chief Johnson advised that he was having some difficulty with the phone company in that they wanted individual accounts for each department. Chief Johnson stated that another meeting was scheduled for next week to attempt to consolidate the bill.

Chief Johnson also recommended that departments check the State Contract before purchasing their computer.

Chief J. Goodman made a motion to install telephone line to each station. Each station will be responsible to run their on interior lines and will be responsible for any additional charges. Motion was second by Chief K. Herndon. Motion carried.

Chief Johnson was given permission to begin receiving quotes for the server.

The Fire Marshal stated that repairs on the smoke house were being made. He advised that the Heat/AC unit would need repaired or replaced.

Chief J. Goodman made a motion to replace the unit. Motion was second by Chief J. Marsh. Motion carried.

NEW BUSSINESS:

President Hall stated that next month was election of officers. Nominations should be presented to the executive committee as soon as possible.

Chaplian Mitchell briefed the association on a new program called "Shield the Badge with Prayer" and encouraged all members to participate. Forms were distributed to those present.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn at 21:00 hours.
