Monthly Meeting 26 January 1987, Station 26, Beaver Dam Fire Department.

The meeting was called to order and invocation was given by Chaplain Junior McLean. Roll call was taken and there were 18 departments and 10 associate members present. Minutes from the December meeting were read and approved. Treasurers report for December 86 was presented and approved.

Guests: Mr. Johnny Evans, Cumberland County Commissioner.

I. OLD BUSINESS:

1. County Attorney discussed the new Fire Prevention Ordinance passed by the County Commissioners last week. The ordinance is in effect now, the records and reports will take effect on July 1, 1987. In order for the Fire Marshal to come up with a standard form for fire reports and inspections it is requested each department mail copies of current forms to him for consideration.
2. There has been no decision concerning the mobile air system rotating to different stations as approved last month. The County Attorney will seek approval from county officials as soon as possible.
3. A committee will be formed to up-date the association By-Laws. The committee will be made up of the Executive Committee, and the Chairman and Vice Chairman of each committee. This group will meet Wednesday, 4 February, 1987. at Station 7, 1930 hours.

II. COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1. Communications: Fire reports for November, December, and Annual Report for 1986 was submitted. Doc Nunnery gave report on new encoder system. Piedmont Communications has the bid for new system which is currently being programed.
2. Education & Training: Eastern Fire Seminar plans are going smoothly. There is an added class on Survivair Maintenance. Any station having personnel wanting to attend this class should contact FTI as soon as possible. All departments are invited to display equipment during the seminar.
3. Standards/ Mutual Aid: No report.
4. Planning & Research: No report.
5. Public Relations: No report.
6. President Johnson submitted the new committee selections for 1987 to the association for approval. Recommendation made by Chief Arvil Crites, seconded by Chief Kevin Herndon. Roll call vote followed with 18 approving, 1 disapproval.

III. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Mr. Jerry Bloom, FTI, went over a new SOP on Live Burn Procedures. Copies were handed out to each department.
2. Fred Proctor, President of the Cumberland County Firefighters Association was introduced. He requested assistance during the Eastern Fire Seminar from any department. Also, there is a promotional magic show being offered by the Assoc. There is an organization making telephone calls to county residents concerning this program.
3. John McInnis, Emergency Management, requested membership into the association. Motion by Chief Arvil Crites, seconded by Chief Jeff Oliver, voted and approved by the membership.
