7. There was some discussion concerning departments purchasing new radio,s and the association asked that the communication,s committee look into a P.L. CODE that could be assigned to all radio,s in the county.
8. John McInnis announced a managing cert function course will be held at FTCC in June 1988, there is to be further information mailed out concerning this class.
9. President Johnson asked the chairman of the firefighters association report back at the next meeting what the funds from the Eastern Fire Seminar were being used for.
10. There was a concern within the association to support candidates for political office.
11. President Johnson announced that there would be a special called meeting of the fire chief,s to be held at station 2 on May 9, at 7:30 p.m. to discuss the candidates for office that the association will support.
12. Wayne Burns announced that Ronnie West is serving as Fire Chief for Hope Mills.
13. Chief Mike Middleton advised that if his budget was approved, he would be hiring three fireman, July 1, 1988.
14. Chief Terry Riley announced that he had an opening for a firefighter at station 10.
15. Chief Steve Blackburn announced that his station was accepting applications for employment.


