MONTHLY BUSINESS MEETING

January 23, 1995

The meeting was hosted by the Spring Lake Fire Department in the Gateway Room at the Gateway Inn. The association wishes to thank Chief Patrick Stevens and his staff for the meal and hospitality.

The meeting was called to order at 19:45 hours by President Hall; roll was called, 19 departments were represented and 10 associate members present.

Secretary and Treasure's reports were approved as read.

OLD BUSINESS:

Chief J.F. Hall announced that the Foam Committee had met to decide placement of the foam trailers. The following stations are recipients and have agreed to accept the responsibilities of responding and maintenance: Stations 2, 11 and City Station 7. The manufacture will provide a 2-4 hour block of instruction for operation. It is the intentions of the committee to open this training to all interested departments.

Marshal Faircloth announced that he has been appointed as the Liaison Officer for the Cumberland County Commissioners to the Fire Chief's Association.

Chief Freddy Johnson announced that the checks to the nine (9) distressed fire departments have been mailed.

President Hall disseminated the list of committee members to those present. He requested that committee chairman conduct regularly scheduled meetings and present a report at each monthly association meeting.

Brett Irwin's application to the Arson Task Force was passed on to Commander Freddy Johnson.

Chief Mike Middleton passed around a department officer list and requested that departments update their station's officers. A new list will be distributed at the next meeting.

Discussion concerning the radio interference was held; President Hall task the Communications Committee with checking for alternatives.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

E.O.C. - Doc Nunnery commented on the radio interference, he advised that the committee consider an 800 system.

FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE - Rickey Strickland presented the Firefighter of the Year Award to Brian Marley, Pearces Mill Fire Department. Officer of the Year was presented to Assistant Chief Mike Godwin of Boonie Doone Fire Department. Mr Strickland also advised that information regarding CO2 monitors and UL Standards was on the executive table.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT - Sherry Grabowsik announced upcoming classes be sponsored thru her office. She also advised that she was updating the resource manual and requested that all departments advise her of any changes.

F.T.C.C. - Bill Vile announced that department envelopes were on the executive table and announced upcoming classes. Mr. Vile also gave an update on registration for the 1995 E.E.S.S. seminar.

SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - Sheriff Butler commended all departments for their support to the Arson Task Force and offered any assistance necessary. He also advised that arrangements had been made that when available, a deputy would assist with traffic and crowd control when needed.
